In order to be eligible for consideration, a teacher from a school can submit an application for a specific grade level OR a school librarian can submit an application for books that range multiple grade levels. There can only be one application submitted per school. Most books are elementary age appropriate. APPLICATIONS ARE DUE OCTOBER 24, 2016!!

The books will be selected by the YF&R Education Sub-committee and will be chosen from the American Farm Bureau Foundation for Agriculture's book database. They will cover various agriculture topics based on the grade levels receiving the books.
