The Oklahoma Farm Bureau Women's Leadership Committee has joined with the Oklahoma Farm Bureau Foundation for Agriculture to provide accurate agriculture books to schools across our state.

In order to be eligible for consideration, a teacher from a school can submit an application for a specific grade level OR a school librarian can submit an application for books that span multiple grade levels. There can only be one application submitted per school. Most books are elementary-age-appropriate.

Applications are due September 16, 2019

The books will be selected by the Women's Leadership sub-committee and will be chosen from the American Farm Bureau Foundation for Agriculture's book database. They will cover various agriculture topics that are appropriate for the grade levels receiving the books.

Winners will be awarded at the Flapjack Fundraiser at the OKFB annual meeting on Saturday, Nov. 9th.
